The Panhandle Butterfly House

The Panhandle Butterfly House and Nature Center originally began in 1986 located in Navarre. We purchased the historic Jones House and property and relocated to 4966 Henry Street, Milton in 2020. The approximate 10 acres property includes a conservation easement protecting the Blackwater River floodplain ecosystem which visitors can observe on the 1/4 mile Tiger Nature Trail. Visitors can experience live butterfly encounters in the vivarium and see over 300 species of butterflies and moths on display from various parts of the world.

We are open from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Wednesday through Saturday excluding holidays. Visitor entrance fees are \$7 for adults 18 years and older, \$5 for youth ages 5-17 years, and 4 and younger are free.


