

Leadership Santa Rosa Class 37 Media Day



On August 15, Leadership Santa Rosa participants gathered for Media Day, an event designed to explore the dynamic relationship between media and the community. The day was led by facilitators, Jodi Bell and Matt Newcomer. The goals for the day included assessing the impact of media on the community's quality of life and familiarizing participants with the media landscape in Santa Rosa County.

The day began at the Economic Development Office in Milton with breakfast sponsored by Erin Vaughn and Sunbelt Title. The first session of the day featured a Community Media Panel where experts, Lisa Newell, Gail Acosta and Romi White discussed the role the Gulf Breeze News, Santa Rosa Press Gazette, Navarre Press and Santa Rosa News play in the community.

Sarah Whitfield, Public Information Officer for Santa Rosa County, then led a session sharing her experiences and giving tips to the class about dos and don'ts when working with the media.

Participants then traveled to WEAR ABC Channel 3 in Pensacola. The tour provided a behind-the-scenes look at how television news is planned and produced, offering a firsthand experience through watching a live broadcast and meeting news anchors.

Lunch at the Pensacola News Journal (PNJ), sponsored by the newspaper, featured a Q&A session with journalists, Brandon Girod and Jim Little. This interaction deepened participants' understanding of the ethical issues that influence news reporting. A workshop featured exercises where participants faced scenarios of potential challenges encountered by reporters, allowing them to step into the role of journalists. In another exercise, the class acted as news producers, determining which stories to lead with on the newscast and how much time to allocate to potential headlines.

In the afternoon, the group toured CatCountry 98.7 and NewsRadio 92.3 / AM1620 interacting with radio personalities, Brent Lane and Andrew McKay.

The day concluded back at the Economic Development Office, where participants reflected on their experiences and completed a survey. Media Day successfully achieved its goals, offering a comprehensive view of the media landscape, the challenges faced by media professionals, and the critical role media plays in shaping the community's quality of life.
